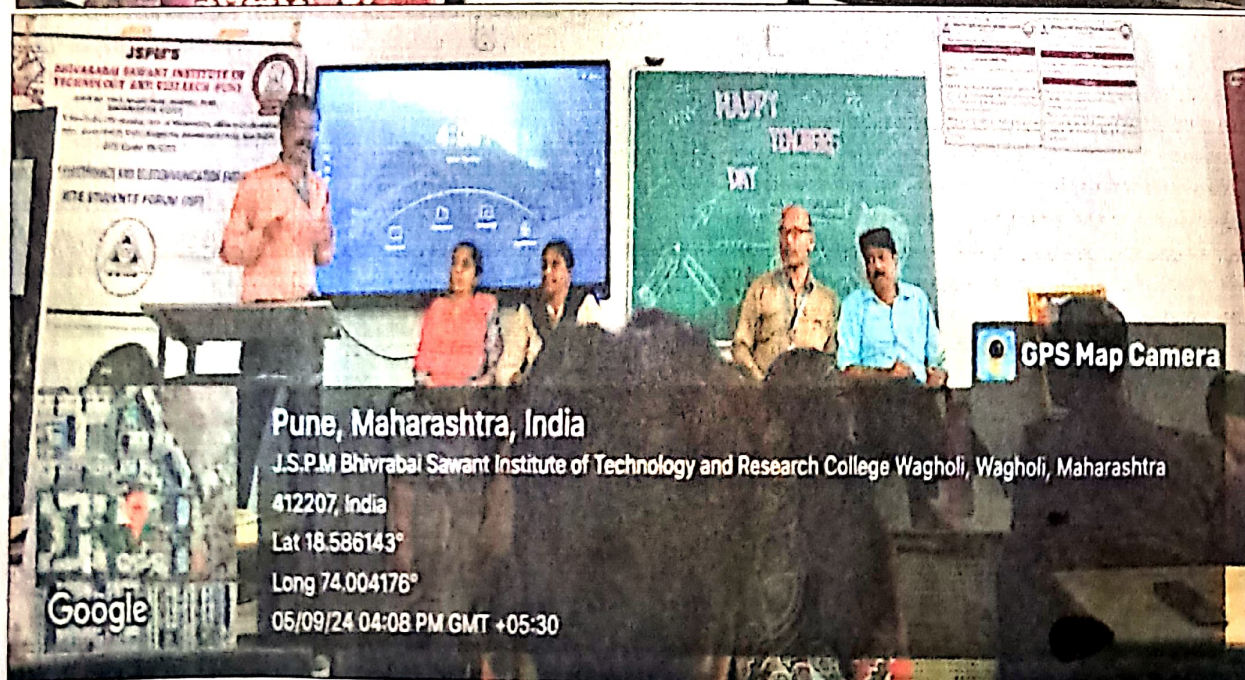
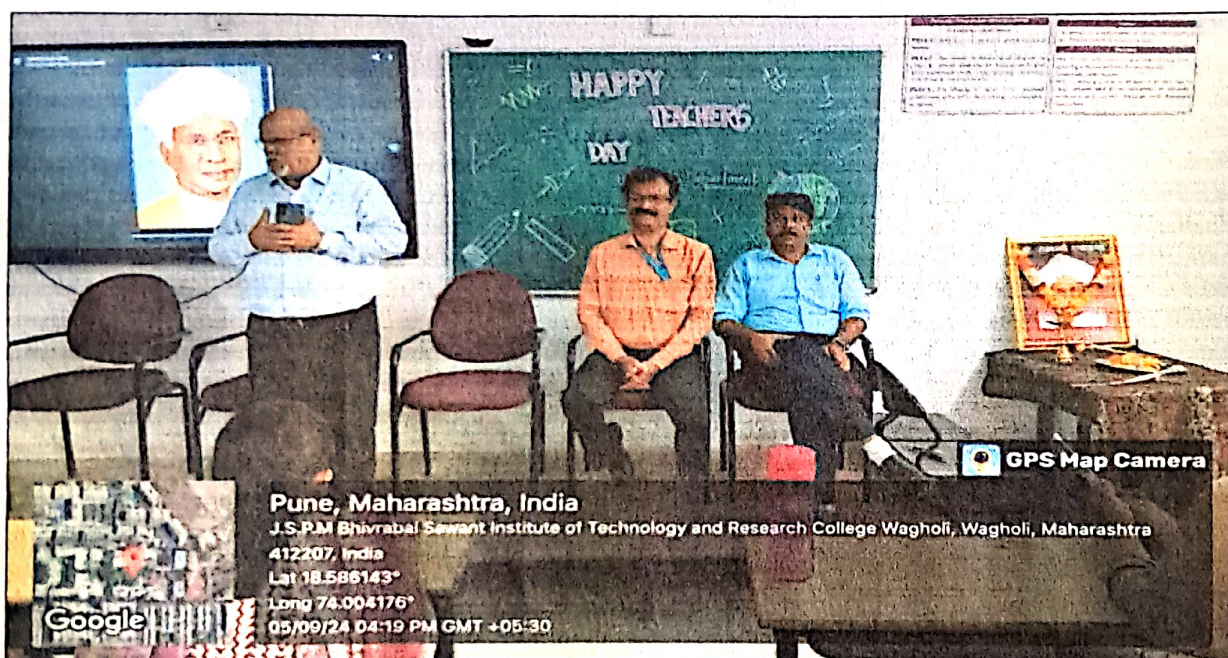
Introduction:

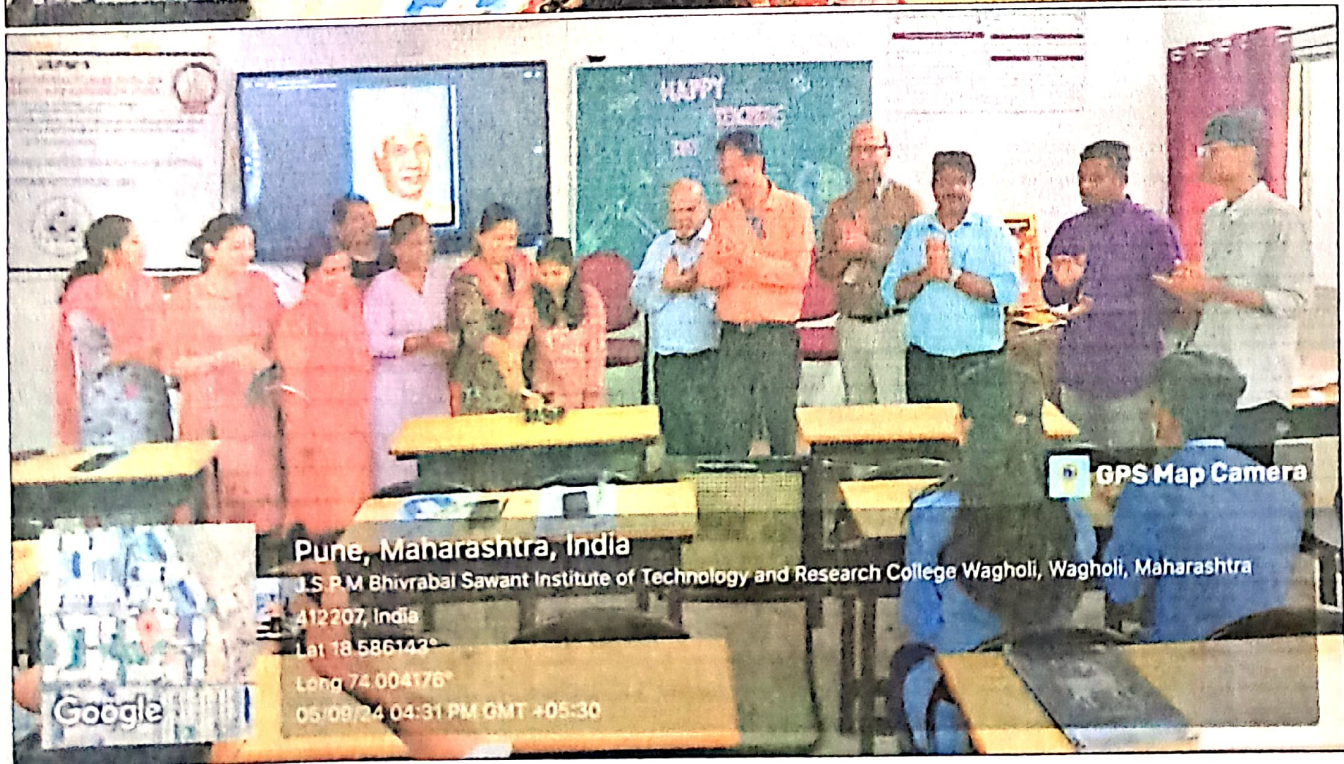
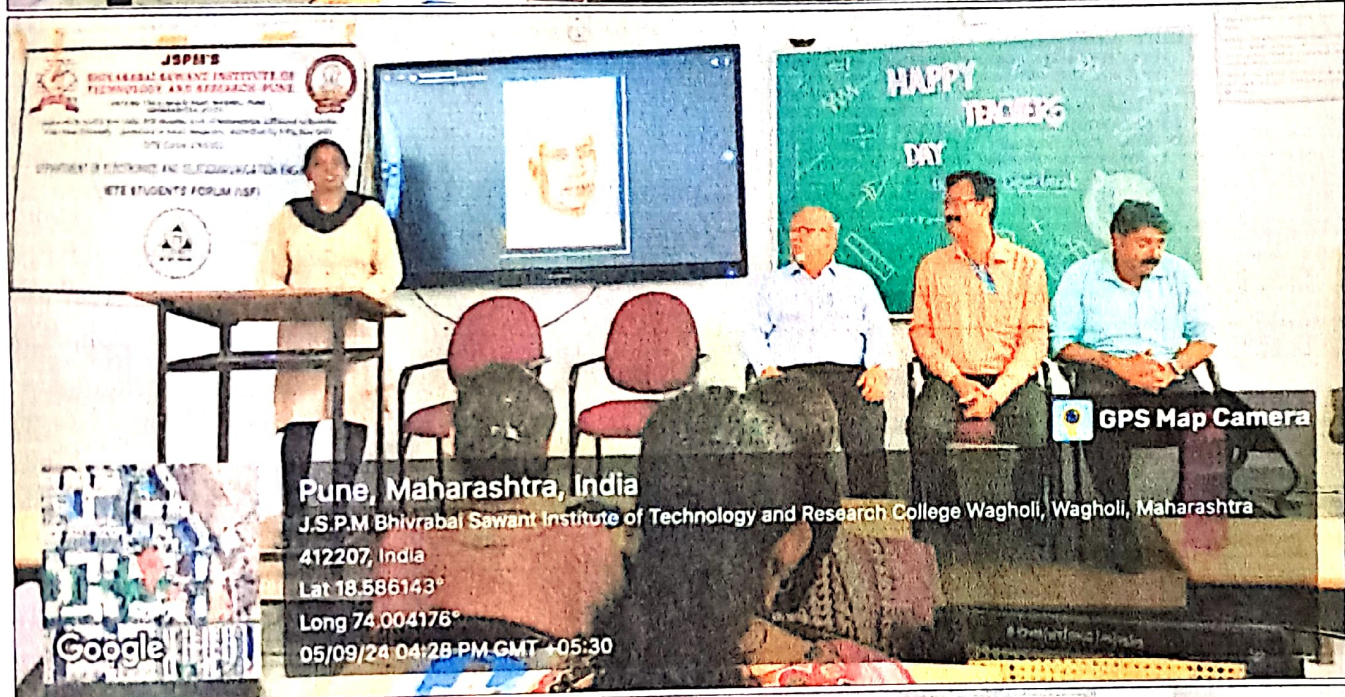
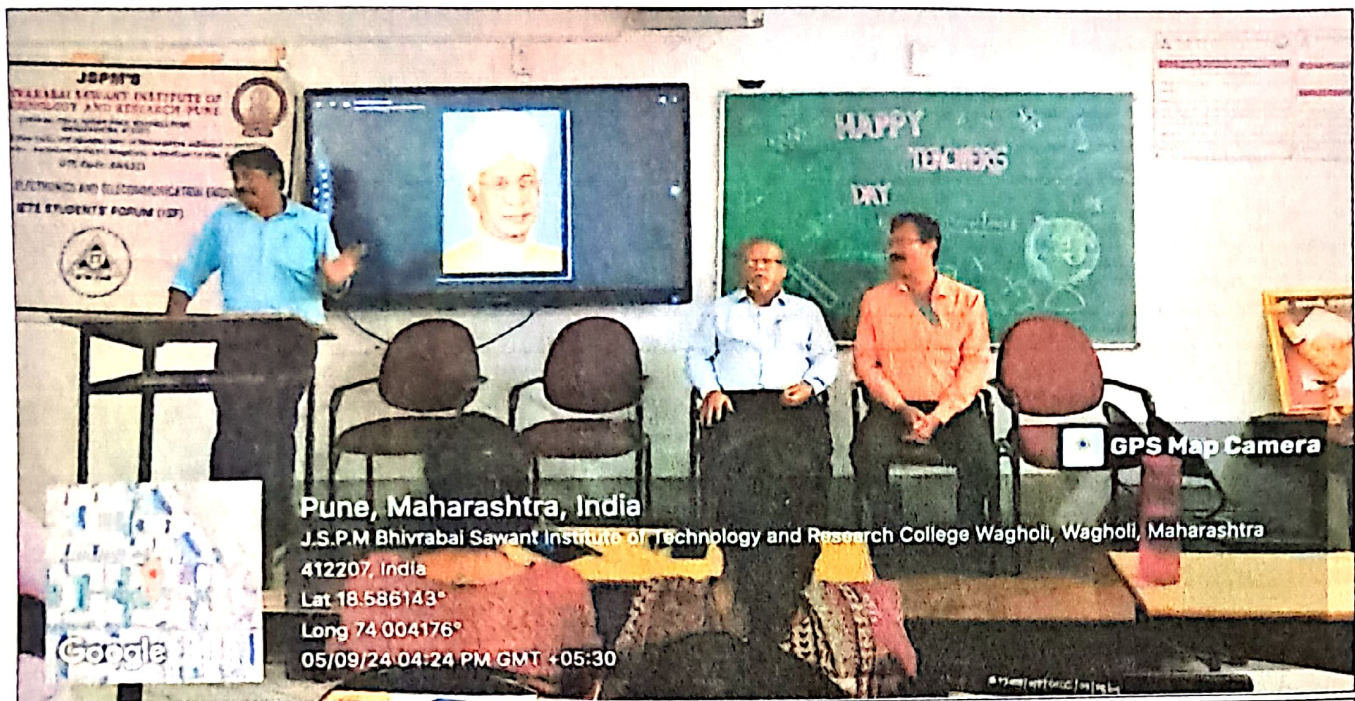

In India, Teachers' Day is traditionally observed as a day to venerate teachers, the birth date of the second President of India, Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, 5 September 1888, has been celebrated as Teacher's Day since 1962. The day has been marked for the celebration as Teachers' Day since 1962 in respect and deference of Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan. He was a great scholar, philosopher and teacher of modern India and was awarded the Bharat Ratna in 1954. He became the first Vice President of India (from 1952 to 1962) and the second President of India (from 1962 to 1967). It was his wish that instead of celebrating his birthday on 5th of September every year, it would be better to celebrate it as Teacher's Day all over India. Therefore, it was only natural that his birthday would be celebrated as Teacher's day to pay respect towards teachers across the country. To mark the importance of this day, we celebrate Teacher's day in our college.
