Why Experiencial Learning

Issues Relating to Engineering Education :

- Engineering Education is disjoint from Vocational Training.
- Curricula lag behind the need of industry.
- Engineering graduates lack aptitude for practical aspects of building, commissioning and testing thing.
- Teaching-Learning processes normally don't emphasize on innovation, exploratory learning and constructivist approach. Focus on R&D is minimal.
- Sensitivity towards "relevance to society" remains dismal low.
- There is emphasis more on Lectures (theory) and less on Practicals.
- Poor (English) communication skills.
- Use of open technologies/standards is not encouraged.
- Interest for higher education or entrepreneurship is lacking.





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Once your first prototype is built, you may find flaws that need to be corrected before you seek a patent. You may need to build several prototypes to get a good one done. Typically, early working prototypes are built of less expensive materials than later versions to save money while fixing design flaws. As you improve your design, you can eventually make a prototype that replicates your actual product as it will be sold to consumers.

4. LOCATE A MANUFACTURER

Once you have a working prototype, you're technically ready to apply for a patent; however, you might want to take the additional step of locating a manufacturer that can produce your product at a profitable price. If your idea is going to be profitable, you need to be able to build it at a cost that is low enough that you can cover expenses without cutting too far into your revenue.

Manufacturers that offer free samples and 3-D printing can help you cut costs both in testing and production phases. Go to multiple suppliers and manufacturers to get estimates, so you can determine the most cost-efficient materials and methods for putting your prototype into production.

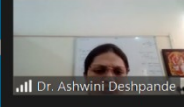
