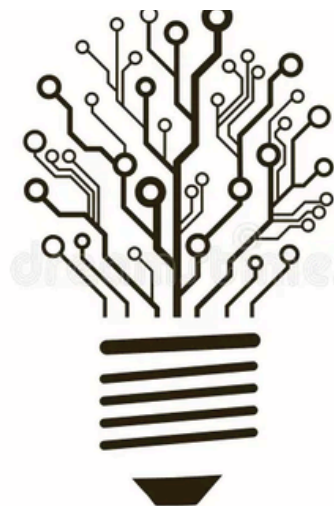

Students gained valuable insights into cyber laws and digital safety.



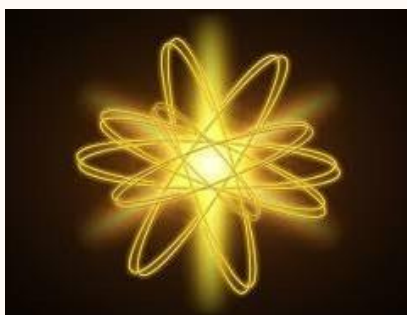
Energy

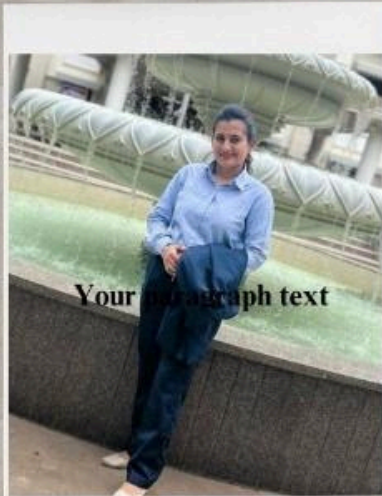

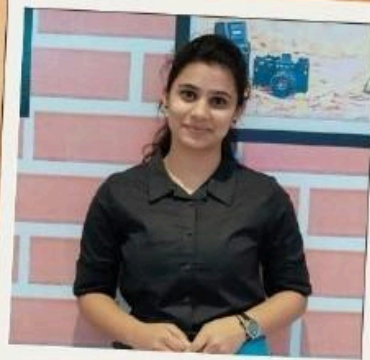

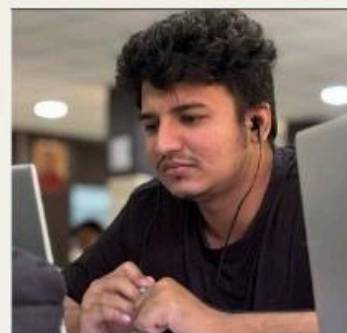
